


Class Vega have been learning about Monet and his love for painting. We have learnt about his style of painting and have tried to show this by continuing one of his seascapes.





Class Arcturus have produced an independent piece of writing about an explorer named John Cabot.






In Class Canopus we have been constructing Viking longboats. We will be scoring and cutting, as well as hot glueing and painting, The shields, oars and sails will be added later.
