We are hosting a family carol concert in the school hall for families to attend. There will be a selection of well-known traditional Christmas Carols sung by the children. Due to space, tickets (which are free) are limited to 2 per family and allocated on a first come first serve basis. Once we have reached capacity, we will close orders and adopt waiting lists. All tickets can be ordered through Parent Pay and are available to order from Thursday 21st November.

Tuesday 17th December – EYFS – Y2 Nativities @ 10am and 2pm

Tickets are available via Parent Pay and can be allocated for one or both performances up to a maximum of 2 per family for the event and are available from Thursday 21st November. If you wish to order more than 2 tickets, a waitlist will be created – please email the office to ask to be added to it.

We do appreciate the timings of the Nativities may not suit every family and for this we are sorry. It was decided as a school that to support our youngest children, performances would occur in school time.

Wednesday 18th December – Christmas Fayre

We are excited to host our annual Christmas Fayre. We are changing the way we pay for items during the fayre. Tokens will be available to purchase either in advance or on the day (and you can buy as many as you want during the event too). They will be available either via Parent Pay or cash at the school office and on sale from Monday 2nd December.

Tokens will not be issued until the event but a log will be made and tokens allocated as required – collection will be from the office.

Tokens can be exchanged in different quantities for *any* stall or event at the fayre and replaces the need for cash to be handled across all stalls. It is a safer, more efficient method of payment and means we can reuse the tokens across other events.
