Late Attendance

Please ensure your child is on time for school. It is really important for your child to be on time to avoid disrupting lessons and loss of learning. If your child has a persistent late record you will be asked to meet with the Head Teacher and/or the Attendance and Pupil Support Officer to resolve the problem, but you can approach us at any time for advice and support if you are having problems getting your child to school on time.

Reception Screening

- New continuous cough.
- High Temperature.
- Loss of taste/smell

From 1 March 2021, if you're a member of a household, childcare bubble or support bubble of staff or a pupil you can get a twice-weekly test:

- Through your employer if they offer testing to employees
- At a local test site
- By collecting a home test kit from a test site
- By ordering a home test kit online
