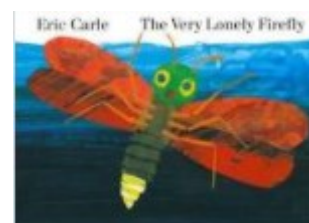
Key facts
