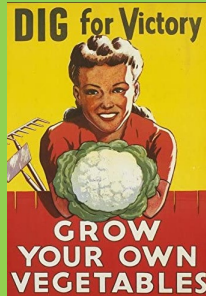
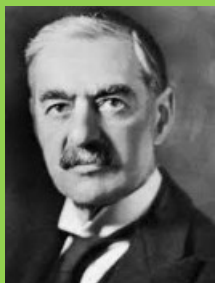

Vocabulary	Definition
Allies	Great Britain and the countries who fought on our side.
Appeasement	Policy of agreeing to demands to avoid conflict.
Axis	Germany and the countries who supported the enemy.
Evacuee	A person moved away from the place of danger.
Black Out	The practise of minimising outside light.
Rationing	Allowing people to have a fixed amount of food per day in order to stay fit and healthy.
'The Blitz'	The night time bombing raids on London and major cities by the axis forces.
The Holocaust	The mass killing (genocide) of Jews and other minorities by the German forces.
Propaganda	Information that is biased or misleading spread to alter public opinion.

1 Sep, 1939 – Germany invades Poland - WWII begins
 May-Jun 1940 – Germany takes over most of Western Europe
 Jul-Oct 1941 – The Battle of Britain
 7-8 Dec 1941 – Japan attack US. US joins Allies
 4 Jun 1942 – Battle of Midway. US beats Japan
 6 June 1944 – D-Day – allies invade Normandy
 7 May 1945 – Germany surrenders
 Aug 1945 – The US drops atomic bombs on Japan
