### Reminders

Please return your laptop to the school office once your isolation period has finished.

**Uniform:** Please contact the office if you would like to order any uniform for September. Please note all KS2 Children (Years 3- 6) are required to wear a tie and V-neck Jumper/Cardigan. (Cash payment only)

**Milk:** If your child receives a Free School Meal and you would like them to have a carton of milk each day in the Autumn term please confirm with the school office no later than 12pm on Tuesday 20th July 2021.

If your child does not receive a Free School Meal but you would like to purchase milk, you can do so by logging into your parent pay account to make your payment of £11.65 for the term.



Please bear in mind **lateral flow tests** are for those who are **Asymptomatic**. Around 1 in 3 people with COVID-19 do not have symptoms. Rapid lateral flow tests help to find cases in people who may have no symptoms but are still infectious and can give the virus to others

If your child or a member of your household start to display any of the key symptoms please isolate your entire household and book a PCR test. Call 119 or visit: [www.nhs.uk/coronavirus](http://www.nhs.uk/coronavirus) to arrange a test for the symptomatic person. The PCR test will provide the most accurate result within 1-3 days. You must then notify school that your child is self-isolating.

**Once you have received a negative result please inform the school office before your child returns to school.**

Please remain vigilant, it is important that we are cautious to help stop the spread of the virus and to avoid any bubble closures. Please continue to follow our one-way system and wear a mask when dropping off and collecting your child(ren). Thank you for your cooperation.

**Your child MUST remain at home if they have been asked to self-isolate.**
