English This half term we will be reading the book 'Winter of the Wolves which links to our Anglo Saxons and Vikings struggle for the Kingdom of England topic. We will use the story as inspiration for a number of writing styles including descriptions and narratives.	<u>Science Y6</u> This term we will be exploring Evolution and Inheritance. We will look at how living things have changed over time and how fossils tell us what inhabit- ed the Earth millions of years ago. <u>Science Y5</u> Our learning in Year 5 will focus on Forces. We will learn about the force of gravity and identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces.		 <u>Maths</u> Our objectives are: To read, write and compare numbers up to one million (Y5) and ten million (Y6) To round numbers To calculate using formal written methods in all four operations (+ - x ÷) To solve word problems Y5 will learn Roman Numerals to M (1000)
<u>History</u> Our topic this term is the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor . Our topic will consolidate and use previous learning about the Anglo Saxons and Vikings but focus specifically on the changes in England during the Anglo Saxon and Viking times and how England eventually became a united kingdom and country.	Art We will create artwork based on	Anglo Saxon jewellery.	Religious Education We will be learning about special places and journeys. We will learn about how certain places and pilgrimages are important to different faiths.
