

Behaviour statement

- Every pupil understands they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected, and learn free from the disruption of others
- 2. All staff set an excellent example to pupils at all times
- 3. Rewards, sanctions and the use of positive handling are used consistently by staff, in line with the relationship policy
- 4. The **relationship policy** is understood by pupils and staff
- 5. The **exclusions policy** explains that exclusions will only be used as a last resort, and outlines the processes involved in permanent and fixed-term exclusions
- 6. Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions
- 7. Families are involved in behaviour incidents to foster good relationships between the school and pupils' home life

The governing board also emphasises that violence or threatening behaviour will not be tolerated in any circumstances.

This written behaviour statement is reviewed and approved by the governing board every year.
