Maths:

We will also be looking at money, learning about the different coins and how to count money.

We will also be looking at time and how to tell the time to the hour and half hour.

PSHE:

We will be looking at how to keep ourselves clean and healthy.

RE:

We will be studying Christianity and looking at significant stories from the Bible.
