Computing - PowerPoint Presentations

This half term we will learn how to create one of Mrs Bottomley's favourite things - a PowerPoint Presentation! We will learn about the different features and effects which we will then use to create our own presentations about Spain. We will also continue to use **TTRockstars** & **PurpleMash** to support our learning.

We will identify personal strengths & achievements and manage and reframe setbacks. We will recognise risks and hazards.



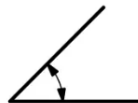
RE

Maths - Properties of Shapes, and Statistics

We will learn about angles and turns, and about 2D and 3D shapes. We will learn to draw 2D shapes and make 3D shapes accurately. We will learn about parallel and perpendicular lines. We will learn about statistics - understanding them and presenting our own statistics in different ways. Please continue to practice 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables.



PE - Athletics

We will develop skills to improve good running posture. We will compete in a long jump from standing position and learn to throw an object safely, aiming to get it as far as possible.
