We will understand how axles help wheels to move a vehicle We will evaluate different designs and will then design and make a stable structure. Finally we will test and adapt elements of our designs.

English

We will be reading the book 'The Paper Bag Princess' by Melanie Walsh. We will be learning about the features of narratives and writing a continuation of the plot. We will also be learning how to write recount style letters.

In our spelling and grammar lessons, we will be learning how to use past and present tense verbs and apostrophes for singular possession.

Maths

In our time unit we will tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times.

We will interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, and tables.

We will also use mathematical vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement.

We will continue to consolidate our addition and subtraction skills as well as the multiplication and division. facts for the 2, 5 and 10 x's tables

Fitness - We will take part in a range of activities to develop components of fitness. We will begin to explore and develop agility, balance, co-ordination, speed and stamina.

Athletics - We will develop skills required in athletic activities such as running at different speeds, jumping and throwing.

We will be learning about the UK coastline. We will identify the human and physical features of the coast/seaside? We will learn how keys and symbols are used in maps and will create our own maps.
