English

This half term we will be reading the book 'Letters from the Lighthouse' which links to our Second World War topic. We will use the story as inspiration for a number of writing styles including diaries and descriptions. We will practise our reading skills each day in our Reading lessons.

Science Y6

This term we will be exploring Evolution and Inheritance. We will look at how living things have changed over time and how fossils tell us what inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.

Maths Our objectives are:

- To read, write and compare numbers up to ten million
- To round numbers
- To calculate using formal written methods in all four operations (+ - x ÷)
- To solve word problems

Religious Education

We will be learning about how Judaism celebrates festivals and why these celebrations occur.
