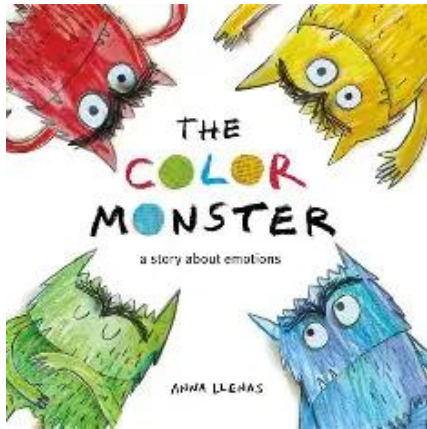


English	Maths	Understanding of the world	We are reading
