We will be focusing on our class book, developing children's understanding of the story and characters. Children will take part in discussions and use ideas from the text to support their writing, with a focus on sentences, vocabulary and presentation.	We will be developing our understanding of place value, addition and subtraction. Children will practise recognising the value of digits, representing numbers in different ways and using a range of strategies to solve addition and subtraction calculations and problems.	Our topic is Materials. Children will explore and identify a range of everyday materials and investigate their different properties. We will also discuss why particular materials are chosen for different objects and purposes.	Our key question is " Why are festivals important? " Children will explore the meaning of festivals within different religions and communities. We will learn about how festivals are celebrated and why they are special to the people who celebrate them.

We will be looking at ground rules and discussing how we can make our classroom ready, respectful and safe place for everyone. Children will think about listening to others, taking turns, showing kindness and making positive choices.	Our focus is team skills. Through a range of games and activities, children will develop their communication, cooperation and teamwork skills. We will also practise listening to instructions, taking turns and encouraging others.	Children will be using Paint 2 to develop their digital art skills. They will explore different drawing and painting tools and learn how to use them confidently to create and edit their own digital pictures.	This term, our Geography topic is 'Looking Through the Keyhole'. We will learn about our local area, places and features that make it special, our country and the United Kingdom. They will learn how to read and use simple maps, recognise and create map keys and symbols, and use compass points.
